The Council has a limited number of full size plots and these are usually offered to existing half plot holders who have demonstrated that they already make good use of their allotment. Current half plot holders offered a full plot will be expected to give up their half plot at the end of the season in September. As allotments are popular, priority from the waiting list will be given to people who do not currently cultivate a site.

To be eligible for an allotment you need to live within the administrative area of Bracknell Town Council.

Allotments may only be cultivated for the production of fruit, vegetables and flowers for domestic consumption by yourself and your family.

In the event of my application being granted, I agree to sign the appropriate agreement when required by the Town Council. I note that the allotment year commences on 29th September each year, I agree to pay the rent in advance which will be calculated pro-rata to the time left in the rental year.
